



FY19 CURBSIDE CHRONICLE (7/1/18 – 6/30/19)

All trash and recyclables **MUST** be placed curbside by **7:00AM**. Recycling will **NOT** be picked up if it is outside of the Town issued Recycle Cart and the lid is not completely closed. All households in the municipal trash and recycling system will be billed an annual fee of \$250.00 to provide basic solid waste and recycling services.

Please keep your current "blue" Recycling Center sticker on your vehicle, the town will continue using the "blue" Recycling Center sticker during FY19. A second sticker can be purchased at the Recycling Center or DPS Office for \$15.00.

Please remember that the carts are the property of the Town and must remain at the address to which they were distributed. Damaged Carts are repaired by appointment. Call: 508-533-3275.

Special Item Curbside Pickup

Every Tuesday we accept "Special Items" defined as LARGE appliances including: **A/C units, dehumidifiers, dishwashers, dryers, freezers, fridges, stoves, trash compactors, washing machines, hot water heaters, and ovens.** Limited to 4 curbside pick-ups and 8 total items per year. **Appointment is required.** Please call: 1-800-972-4545.

***Highlighted** items contain CFCs and must be disposed of professionally. Appointment is required. The Recycling Center will accept the other "Special Items" listed. Residents are responsible for transporting items to the center (46 Broad St).

Please Remember:

ONE "BULK ITEM" per week can be left curbside on your normal trash day (i.e. couch, chair, mattress, carpet rolled in 4' lengths, etc.)

Electronics – Do NOT dispose of electronics (i.e. cell phones, computer monitors, TV, etc.) in trash. Bring to the Recycling Center.

Batteries – Do NOT dispose of rechargeable, button cell, or lithium batteries in trash. Bring to the DPS office or the Recycling Center.

Medical Sharps and Prescriptions shall be disposed at the Medway Police Station (315 Village Street).

Do NOT place recyclables in plastic bags.

NO plastic bags or other plastic films in curbside recycling.

CURBSIDE TRASH

Medway operates a "Pay-As-You-Throw" system of trash collection every week. A 30-gallon bag costs \$1.50 and 15-gallon bag costs \$0.75 (Sold in packs of five). Only trash in specially printed yellow Medway trash bags will be collected curbside and can be purchased at the following locations:

ACCEPTED ITEMS	HOW TO PREPARE	DO <u>NOT</u> INCLUDE
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Normal household trash. Soiled Pizza Boxes, tissues, paper towels, napkins, etc. Latex paint/water based coatings (dried out with kitty litter or sand). Alkaline batteries. Smoke detectors. Small Appliances: toasters, microwaves, coffee makers, blenders, etc. are considered trash and should be placed in yellow bags. Alternatively, residents can donate working items or bring items to the Recycling Center. One Bulk Trash item free per week (i.e. couch, chair, mattress, carpet rolled in 4' lengths, toilets, sinks, windows, doors). 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Place trash out no later than 7:00 AM. Place trash in yellow bags, tied. Bags may be placed in trash receptacle no larger than 35 gal or weigh over 40 lbs. Do not exceed 3" above lip of barrel. Barrels cannot have an attached lid. Only a detachable lid is allowed. Leave at the edge of your property close to the roadway but not in the street or sidewalk. Make an appointment for Special Item Pickup for LARGE appliances. Limited to 4 pick-ups and 8 total items per year. Call: 1-800-972-4545 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No recyclables mixed with trash. No yard waste (bring to Recycling Center). No construction materials (i.e. shingles, bricks, lumber, wallboard, insulation, cement). Contact a private hauler. No tires, car batteries, propane tanks, or fire extinguishers (return to store or bring to Recycling Center.) No hazardous material. See calendar for annual collection day. No Electronics (bring to Recycling Center). No Large Appliances <u>without</u> Special Item Pickup appointment. NO Medical Sharps or Prescription Medication. Dispose at the Medway Police Station (315 Village Street). No rechargeable, lithium, or button cell batteries. NO items containing mercury.

CURBSIDE SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING

Medway collects **single stream** (paper/cardboard/glass/metal/plastic) recycling **every other week** in a 96 gallon wheeled cart. No other container will be accepted. For additional information please use the Trash & Recycling link at www.townofmedway.org.

ACCEPTED ITEMS	HOW TO PREPARE	DO <u>NOT</u> INCLUDE
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Newspaper, paper bags, magazines, phone books, junk mail, catalogs, etc. Clean cardboard, paperboard (cereal boxes, etc.), egg cartons, and juice/milk cartons. Plastic: Milk, juice, water jugs, soda bottles, detergent bottles, or any plastic container with recycling symbol #1-7 (clean). Glass: bottles and jars (clean and not broken). Metal: Tin, steel & aluminum cans, empty aerosol cans, jar tops, etc. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Keep the cart lid closed to keep rain, snow, and animals out. (Clean your cart periodically). Flatten cardboard to fit into container loosely. Remove all plastic or foil liners. Wipe containers clean. Cart must be placed 3' from the curb. Arrows on lid point toward the street. To move the cart, use the handle to tilt it on its wheels to roll it. (Easier to pull uphill and push downhill). 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do NOT place recyclables in plastic bags. No plastic bags (return to store or bring to Recycling Center). No other film plastics. No foam plastics (Styrofoam cups, packaging material, food containers, etc.). No rigid plastics (trash or bring to the Recycling Center). No hazardous material. See calendar for annual collection day. NO small appliances (trash, donate, or bring to the Recycling Center). No porcelain, ceramics, light bulbs, window glass, broken glass, mirrors. No soiled pizza boxes, paper towels, napkins, tissue, paper plates, etc. (compost or trash).

BROAD STREET RECYCLING CENTER: 46 BROAD STREET

Only open to Medway residents who participate in the Town's trash program & have a valid sticker. Stickers must be permanently affixed to your vehicle on the lower driver's side windshield. No commercial vehicles allowed without DPS special permit. Hours of operation are:

Summer Hours: 04/04/18 through 09/25/18 - Wed. 3PM-6PM, Sat. & Sun. 8AM-3PM

Winter Hours: 09/26/18 through 04/02/19 - Wed. 12PM-3PM, Sat. & Sun. 8AM-3PM

Summer Hours: 04/03/19 through 09/24/19 - Wed. 3PM-6PM, Sat. & Sun. 8AM-3PM (Closed Easter Sunday)

For businesses or condos utilizing private trash service we offer a Recycling Only sticker for \$60 and \$30 respectively per fiscal year. This allows only recyclable materials to be brought in (No trash, bulk, leaves/brush, or tires).

(FREE) Swap Shop: Only Reusable Items (Town's discretion). Foam: coolers, packing blocks, & white insulation boards ONLY. (FREE) Mercury Bulbs and Thermometers (FREE) Batteries: rechargeable, button cell, and lithium (FREE) Compost available (FREE) (Self load) Yard waste: Leaves. Brush under 12" wide. Logs between 1'-4' long (no pine). (FREE) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Metal Appliances (fuels/oils emptied) (FREE) Propane/Helium Tanks (FREE) Mattresses or Box Springs (\$15 each) Bulk Items – Wooden Furniture, upholstered furniture, Rugs, (\$15/Cubic Yard) Tires: Passenger/Lt Truck Only (remove rims) (\$3/each) NO Fridges, freezers, A/C units, dehumidifiers, items with CFCs. NO packing peanuts, food containers, pink/blue insulation board NO construction/renovation materials (shingles, bricks, wallboard, insulation, cement, tiles, flooring, siding, doors, windows, etc.).
